Section 1 – What Information Do We Collect?

Personal Information

We may collect the following information:

- Full name
- Contact information including email address
- Physical address
- Phone number
- Demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- Other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers

- IP address

This information is necessary for delivering you a product/service or to enhance your customer experience with us.

Order Information

When you place an order, you must provide us with certain information about the products and services you are seeking to purchase.

Billing Information

When you wish to purchase a product or service, you will be required to provide certain information in addition to the Personal Information and Order Information noted above. Such information may include a debit card number, credit card number, expiration date, billing address, activation codes, and similar information. Although we will have access to the Billing Information, it will also be collected and processed by our third-party payment vendors pursuant to the terms and conditions of their privacy policies and terms of use.

Information automatically collected about you:

As you navigate through our Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies including Google Analytics to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns. This will generally include information about your location, your traffic pattern through our website, and any communications between your computer and our Website. Among other things, we will collect data about the type of computer you use, your Internet connection, your IP address, your operating system, and your browser type.

The information we collect automatically is used for statistical data and will not include personal information. We use this data to improve our Website and our service offerings.

Section 2 – What Do We Do With Your Information?

We require this information to fulfill the request you have on our website. That may include sending you information you requested or granting access to a membership portal or products you have purchased. We also require this information to understand your or service and provide you with the best service possible. We may periodically send promotional emails about new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided. On occasion, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, fax or mail. We may use the information to customize the website according to your interests.

Section 3 - Who Else Can Access Your Personal Data

We do not rent or sell your personal data. We may employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf. Examples may include providing technical assistance, email management, order fulfillment, customer service, website design, collection agencies and marketing assistance. These other companies will have access to the information only as necessary to perform their functions and to the extent permitted by law.

Depending on your activity on our site, you may be sharing data with a trusted third-party partner. We use several third-party companies to manage activities such as email management, data collection or shopping cart management. These include:

We only work with Processing partners who are able to ensure adequate level of protection to your Personal Data.

We may disclose your personal information if we are required by law to do so or if you violate our Terms of Service. Also, if our site is acquired or merged with another company, your information may be transferred to the new owners so that they may continue to sell and support our products and services.

Section 4 - How We Secure Your Data

We do our best to keep your personal data safe. We use safe protocols for communication and transferring data (such as HTTPS) along with anonymizing and pseudonymizing where suitable. We monitor our systems for possible vulnerabilities and attacks. Although we try our best, we cannot guarantee the security of information. However, we promise to notify suitable authorities of data breaches and will notify you if there is a threat to your rights or interests. We will do everything we reasonably can to prevent security breaches and to assist authorities should any breaches occur.

Note, if you have an account with us, it is your responsibility to keep your username and password secret.

Section 5 - Use of Cookies And Pixels

As many commercial websites, our website uses a standard technology called “cookies” and server logs to collect information about how our site is used. Information gathered through cookies and server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our site, and the websites visited just before and just after our own, as well as your IP address.

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer’s hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyze web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
